Annual Progress Report

Oral Report

Following the annual meetings of the Thesis Advisory Committee, students will present an oral progress report (~15 minutes + Q&A) for the local research community detailing their recent results and current experimental direction.

Written Report

In addition to this oral report, students should submit a brief written report electronically to the IMPRS Coordination office.

The written report should not exceed 3 pages, and should contain:

- a. **Title.** The proposal's title, student's name, sponsoring PI, and academic affiliation
- b. **Date of Oral presentation.**
- c. **Summary.** A brief statement of the current progress and results. Suggested length: 1 page
- d. **Future Direction.** A brief statement of the next steps or objectives that the student will pursue in the following year. Suggested length: 1 page.
